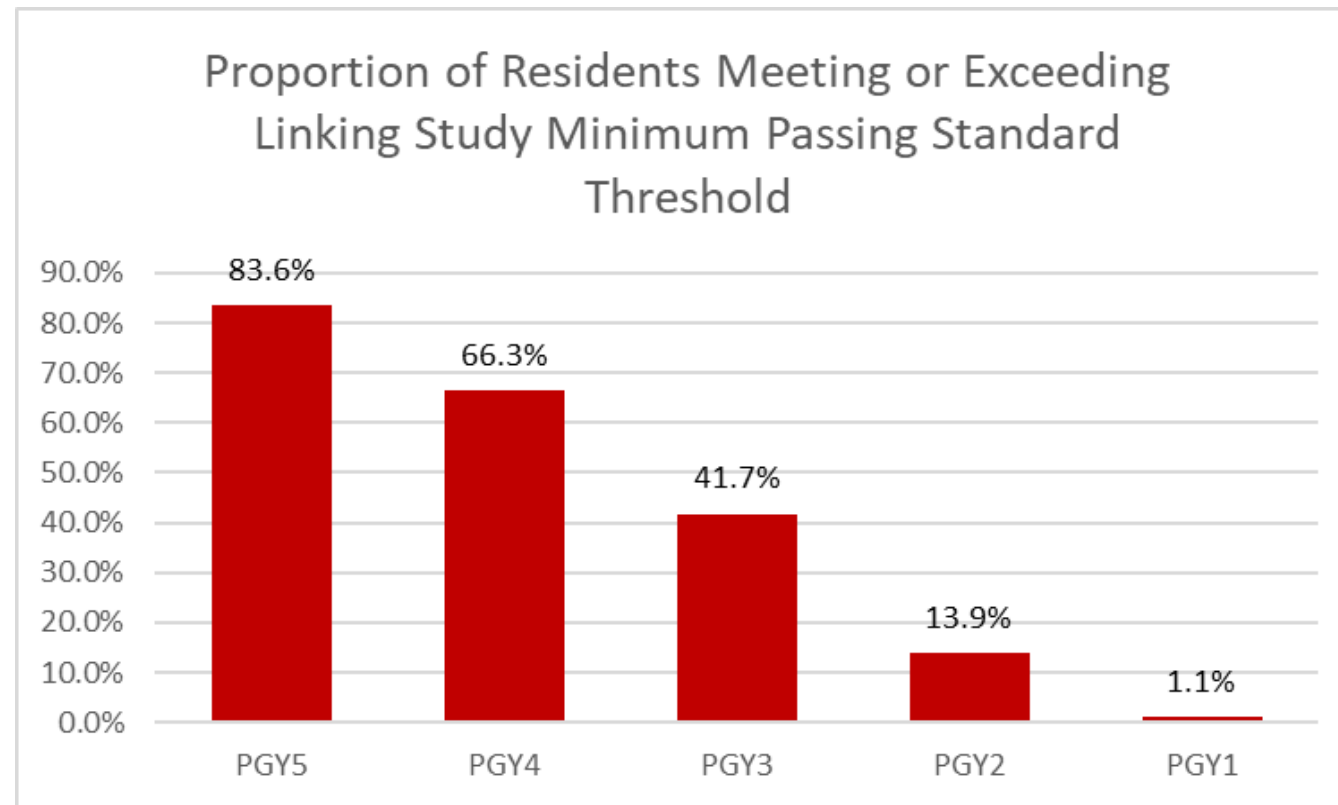

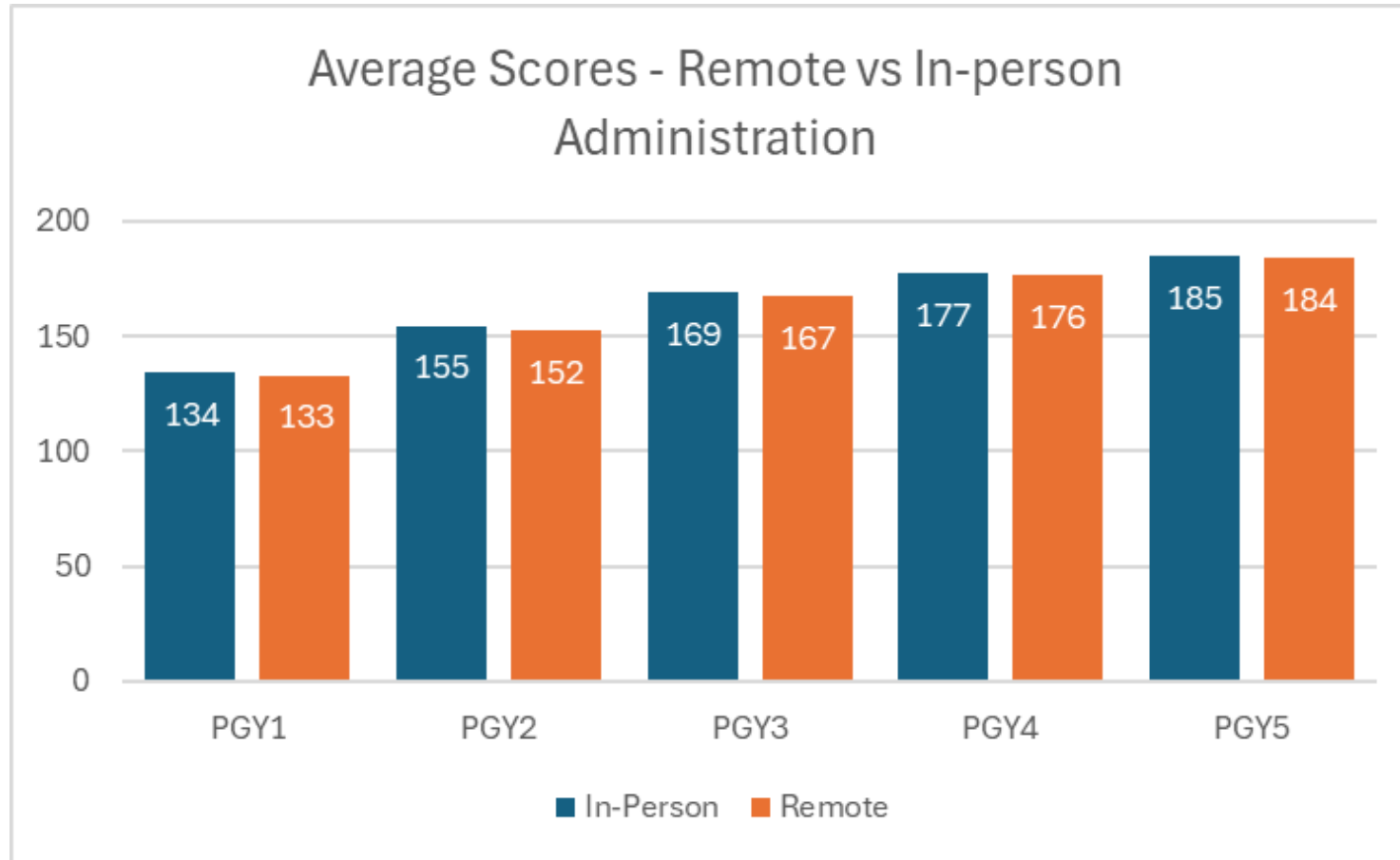

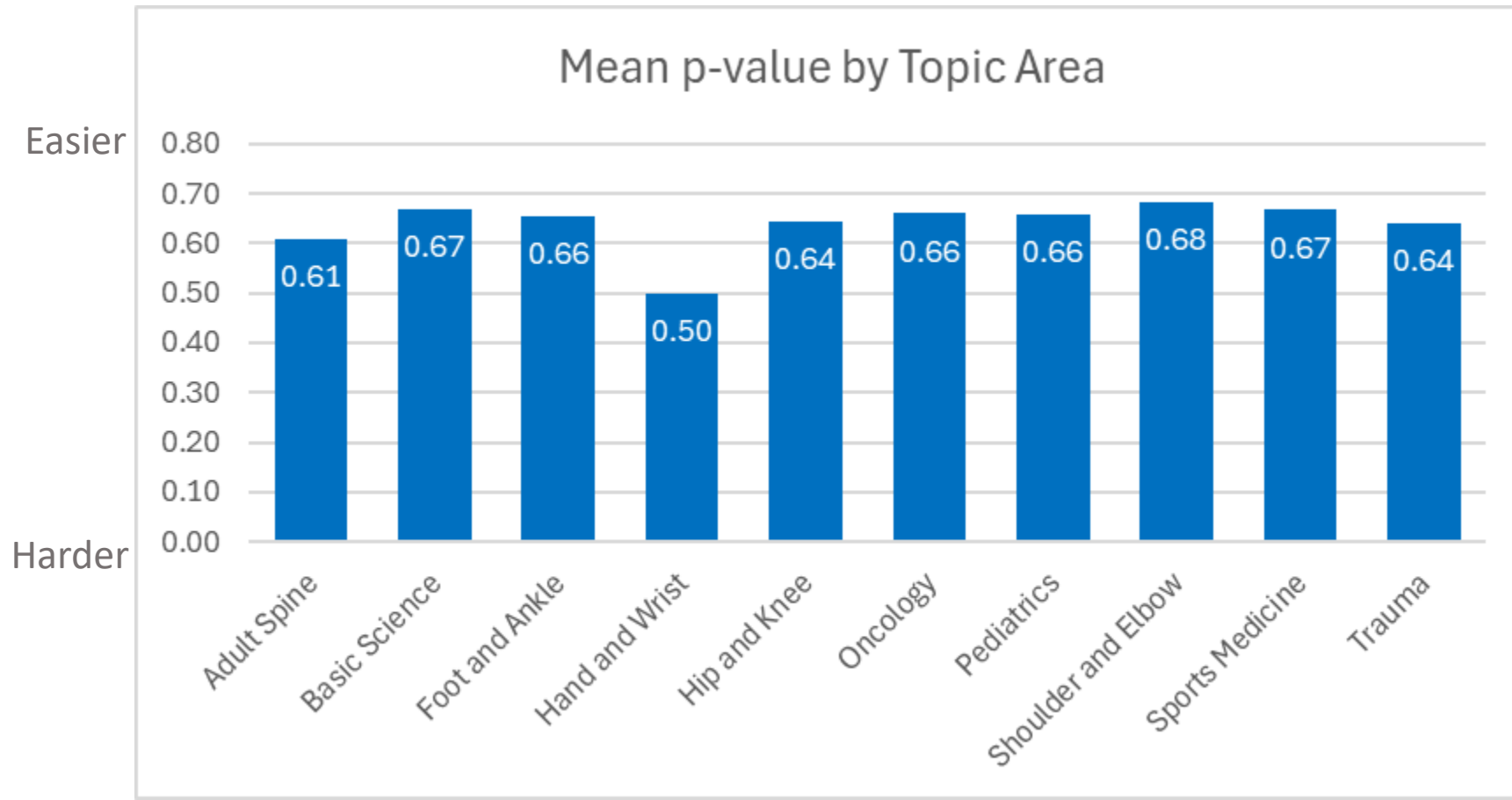


2024 ABOS Linking Study Predicted Passing Score: **172/254** (67.7% correct)

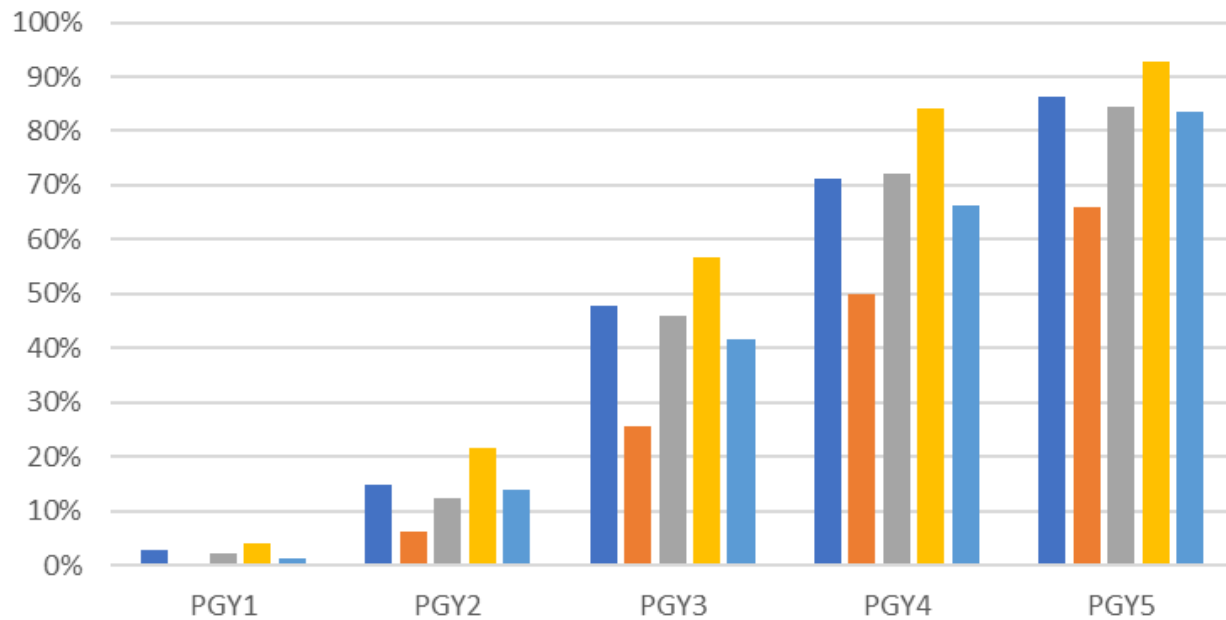




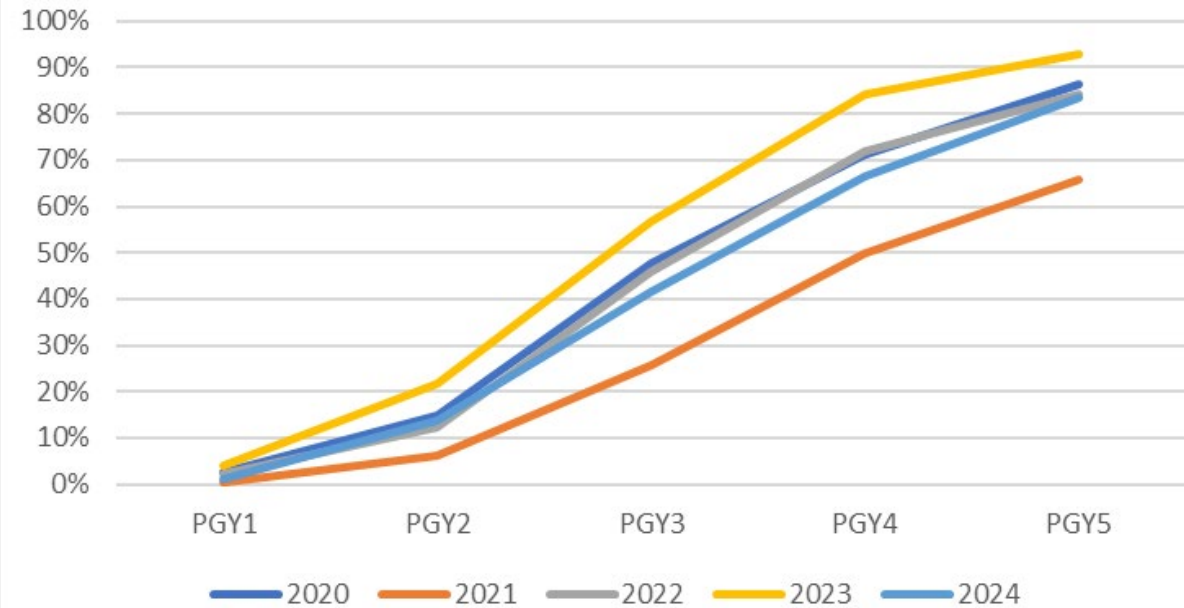

Pass Rate by PGY by Year



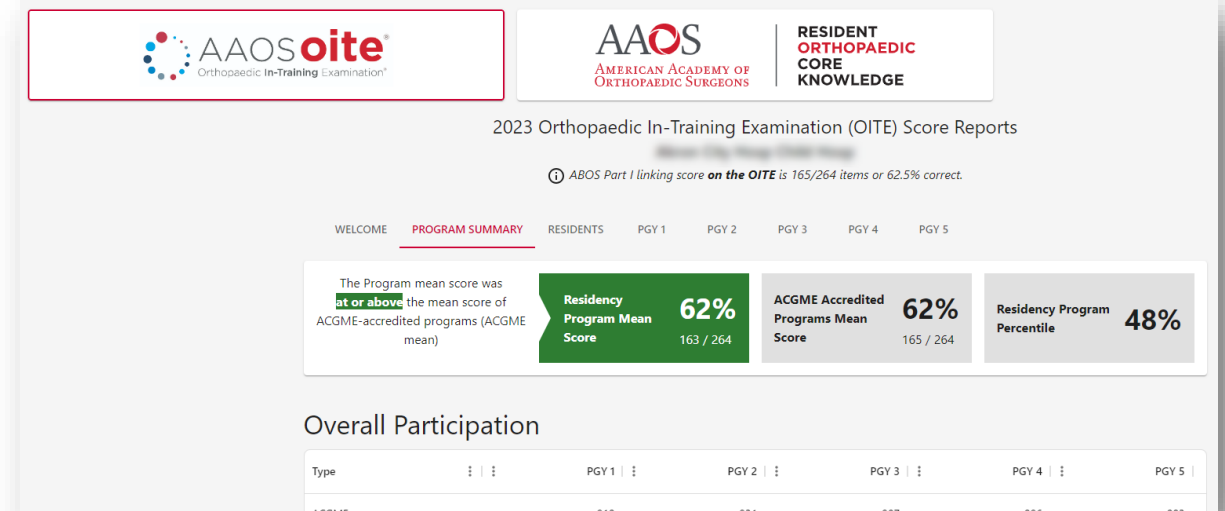

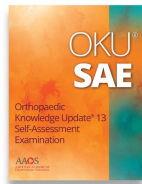
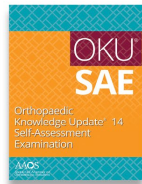


*As expected, we see significant improvements in the knowledge of residents as they advance through their years of training.

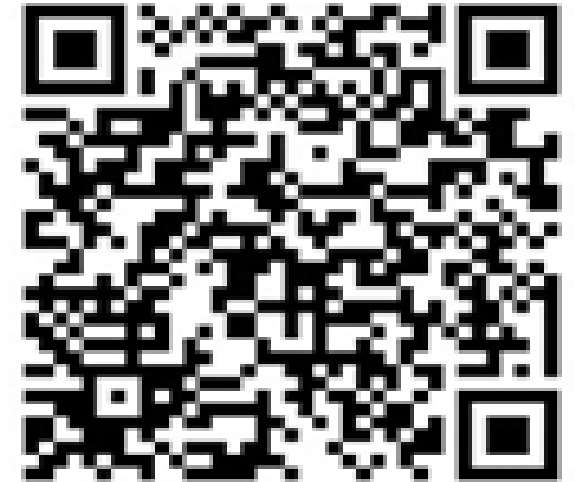

AAOS Resident Membership & Resident Management Portal

New Resident Enrollment & PGY 5 Transition Timelines

Key Deadlines:

- **March** – Email outreach to coordinators to verify contact and program details.
- **April 1 – Portal Opens:**
 - Enrollment of new residents begins.
 - Transition of PGY5 graduates starts – tell us if going into Fellowship or Practice
 - Updates can be made to current resident rosters such as PGY levels, begin and end dates, etc.
- **June 30** – Complete new resident enrollment for benefits starting **July 1** (FREE membership begins)
- **July 31** – Complete PGY5 transitions to Fellowship Members (**or residents risk losing FREE membership**).
- **July 31** – **Portal closes to view-only access.**
- **September 1** – Portal reopens for OITE registrations (closes September 30).

AAOS Membership is FREE for Residents and Fellowship Members

- **Credentials:** AAOS Single Sign-On (SSO) required with username and password.

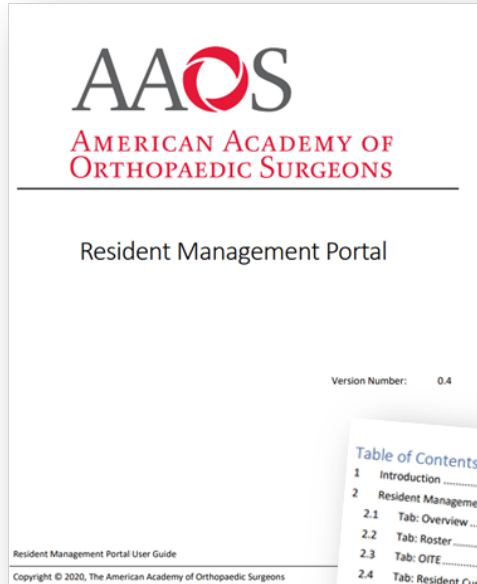
Enrollment/Transition Steps:

1. Click on **Enrollment** or **Roster** tab.
2. Search for residents (**Last Name only** recommended).
3. Enter details – Start date auto-fills **July 1** (adjust year if needed).
4. **Transition PGY5s** – Select **Fellowship or Practice** (Do NOT remove them).
5. Use filter **by PGY** or **by name** to manage roster.

Frequently Asked Questions

I am a new program coordinator. How do I get access to the portal?

Create AAOS record at www.aaos.org. Contact join@aaos.org and the membership specialist will provide next steps and instructions.

I get an error message that I cannot save resident. What should I do?

Click the cancel button and go back to the Resident Search window. Do not enter an email address but search by **last name only**.

How do I change my resident's PGY level?

The PGY level is a non-editable function in the portal. It changes automatically by using the calendar icon; Enter begin date of 7/1 (current year); enter end date of resident's completion ex. 6/30/XXXX. Residents off track, for example, they start 9/1, contact the membership specialist at join@aaos.org.

Do I remove my PGY 5 residents?

No. They must be transitioned. Removing a PGY 5 resident **risks losing their AAOS Membership**. Only Residents leaving the orthopaedic specialty or due to military tour duty should only be removed.

How do I change my resident's profile/record information or email?

Residents should log into their own AAOS accounts to manage, or they can contact the AAOS Service Center at customerservice@aaos.org or 1-800-676-6726 for additional assistance.

ROCK | Response to Need



Comprehensive Content:

Remediate to full text; create a standardized reading curriculum complete with articles and book chapters that ensures a well-rounded education. “Emphasize reading journals and understanding why, not just memorizing facts.”



OITE/Board Study:

“AAOS has the resources and ability to create a great learning resource and curriculum for programs that are not strong academically.”



Downloadable Content/Seamless Integration with Devices:

“Allow the program to transition seamlessly from phone to desktop to tablet and make it available online and offline (not a lot of service in ORs or while traveling).”

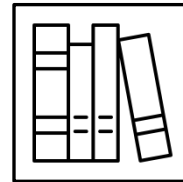

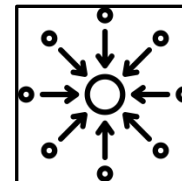
Resident Focused:

“Consider that residents are taught by attendings trained in various settings and with various skill sets, would be nice to see consistency in core clinical knowledge that can be applied across the board.”

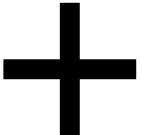


Centralized Education:

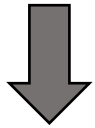

ROCK | Study Schedule Overview

AAOS Default Schedule



- AAOS creates a two-year default schedule; a new two-year cycle will be published every year
- The default schedule is completely customizable to align to your program's education schedule

Customizing

Delete or add chapters to the default weekly assignments

Select entirely new selection of chapters for each default weekly assignment

Blocking

Group pieces of related content together in blocks

Move blocks along the schedule to place in desired dates

Resequencing

Move weekly assignments along to calendar to desired dates

Move blocks of content along calendar to desired dates

Cloning

Clone default schedule before modifying to create multiple schedules

Clone modified schedule to assign out to multiple residents

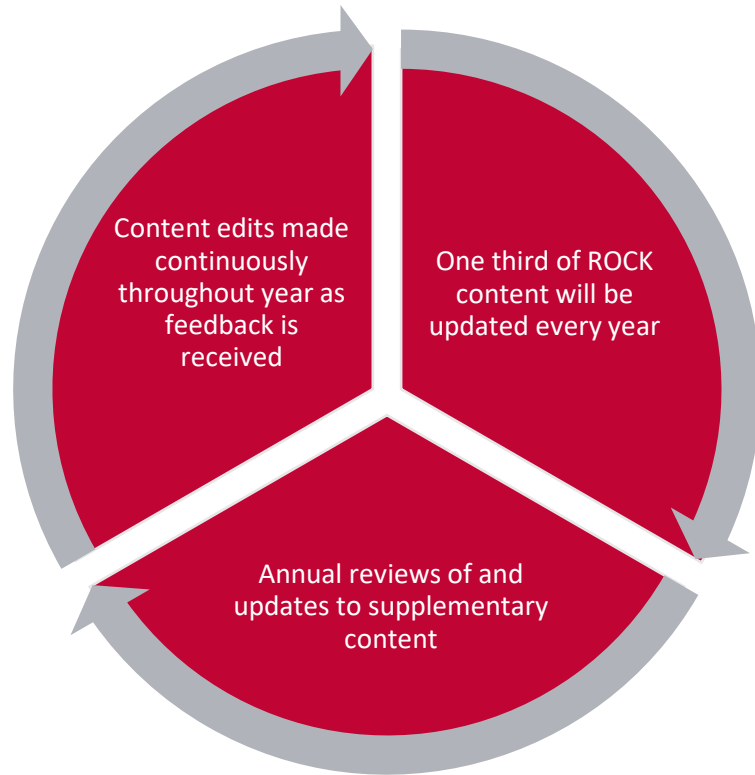
